



Apple/Pear Pollination CHEAT SHEET

Apples can be pollinated by other Apples within their flowering group as well as by those one group earlier or later. (Those in Group 3 can be pollinated by those in Groups 2,3 and 4)

Apples (flowering group):

- Aunt Rachel (1)
- Bevan's Favorite (1)
- William's Pride (2)
- Arkansas Black (3)*
- King David (3)
- Freedom (3)
- Stayman Winesap (4)*
- Enterprise (4)
- Mammoth Blacktwig (5)*
- Black Limbertwig (5)
- Mollie's Delicious (5)

*These apples are triploids. Triploid apples are sterile and cannot cross pollinate other apples. When planting a triploid apple, you will need two other varieties which can cross-pollinate each other as well as the triploid variety.

Most European Pears will cross-pollinate with most other European Pears, Likewise with Asian Varieties. Kieffer is a good pollinator for most pears, including Asian.
